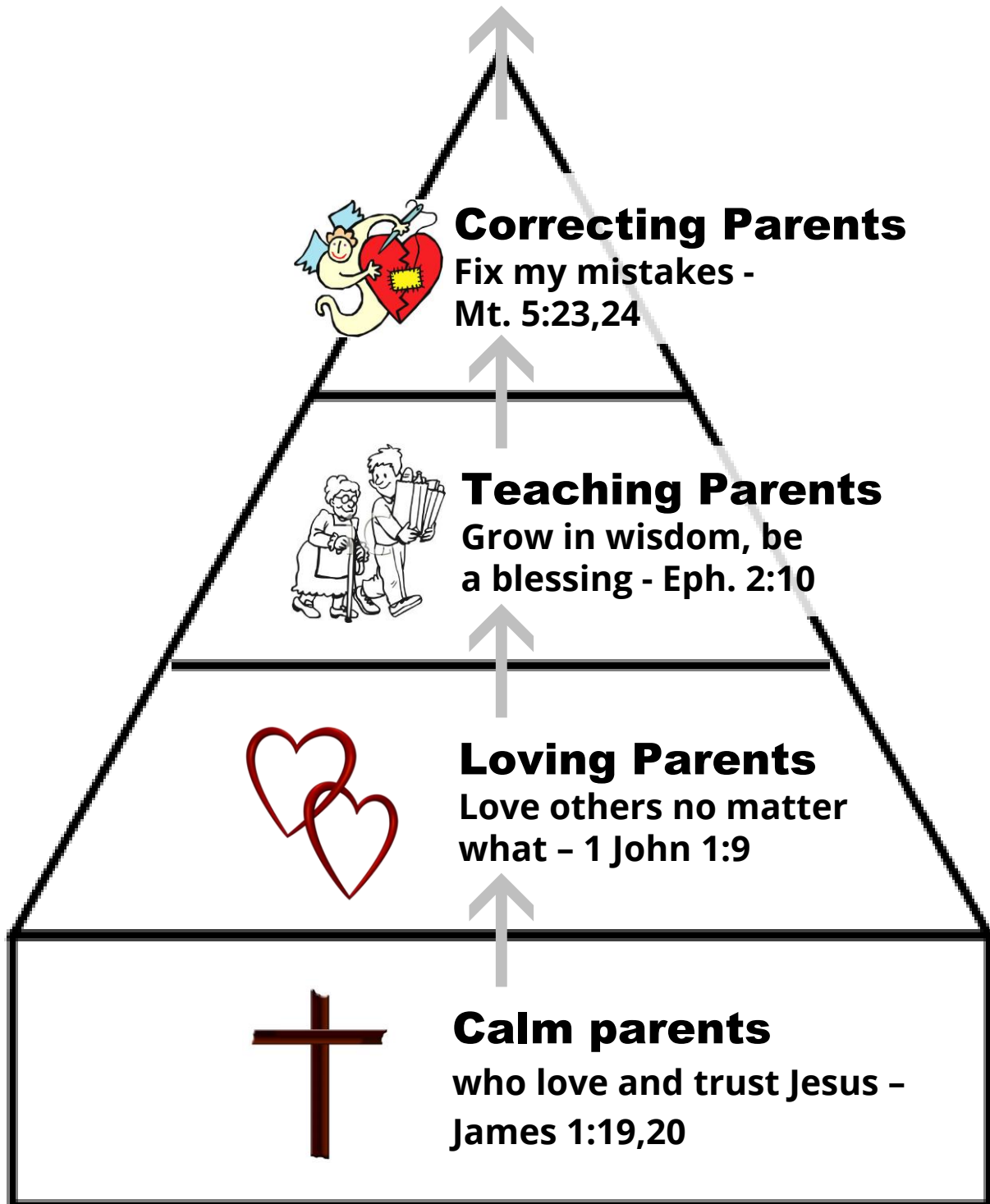


Respectful, faith-filled kids



	Definition / Scripture	What can PARENTS do to guide the family?	What can KIDS do to grow in each level?	What difference would it make if we all really grew in each of these things?
Correct	Fix my mistakes – Mt. 5:23,24	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take responsibility to make it right with someone when I've blown it. • Let kids think first about how to make it right instead of giving a consequence. 		
Coach	Grow in wisdom, be a blessing – Eph. 2:10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask more questions, give less answers. • Help kids celebrate the good stuff that happens. • Plan ways to serve as a family. 		
Connect	Love and enjoy each other – 1 John 1:9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remember to give lots of hugs and kisses. • Remind each other about how much God loves us. 		
Foundation	Know God's love and truth Mt. 7:24-27	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • i.e. take a break to pray when things get tough before responding

Coach	Make a little treasure hunt where you print out and hide directions for something kind to do. Parents give kids clues and hints to find the path to the next "good work" (Eph. 2:10) When kids find the directions (i.e. Hug your brother/call Gramma and sing for her/write a thank you note to your pastor/do a favor for a family member/maybe end with - cook the meal together or bake cookies for a neighbor and deliver). Talk about Eph. 2:10 - God has created us to be a blessing, it brings him glory and us joy!
Connect	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Take a pack of post-it notes and draw little pictures of the fun things you do together, things you love about each other. Put them on a poster as reminders. Make a plan to do some of those things this week. 2) Play the question asking game at meals - everyone thinks up a question to ask someone (who hasn't yet been asked a question), until each person has answered a question.
Foundation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Go outside and look at the foundation of your house, apt. building or church. Talk about what would happen if the rest of the house were just sitting on a sandpile without a foundation. What are examples of storms the family might experience? How does knowing God's love and truth help us stay strong? 2) Look for fun objects outdoors or around the house that remind you of God's love and explain why. If possible, keep that object in view for a few days as a reminder.
