

Moderator for Community Group

Supports and fosters community (through a private Facebook group) for parents who have enrolled in one of the Connected Families online courses or purchased 4 sessions of parent coaching. The community Facebook group provides an opportunity for continued learning, problem-solving, and sharing encouragement and support as parents learn to lead their families with grace.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Fosters a Christ-centered, loving community that is safe for parents to share their challenges and wins.
- Coaches parents in applying Connected Families principles and biblical wisdom to family life.
- Provides accountability and encouragement for parents as they grow and support their children's growth.
- Connects parents to each other and relevant Connected Families resources.
- Promotes online courses, podcasts, articles, and ebooks.
- Work in collaboration with Sarah Donatelle, Care Coordinator of the Community Group

Skill set

- Active faith in Jesus that permeates all of life; an understanding of and eagerness to apply faith to family life.
- Encouragement and exhortation. A heart to see the good and growth in parents and their children.
- Lifelong learner. Willing and eager to continue learning, applying, and sharing scripture, parenting wisdom, and experiences.
- Personal experience parenting children in the target focus for Connected Families resources (ages 3-12), ideally currently parenting.
- Training (or openness to training) in trauma-informed care, adoption, special needs parenting, or other layered dynamics in parenting.
